Nigel worked at National, European and International level on trade union health and safety issues for around 22 years. In January 2003 Nigel established his own consultancy, specialising on worker involvement in health and safety. He is seen as one of the leading authorities on practical worker involvement in the UK and is the author of *ZERO HARM Worker Involvement ... the missing piece*.

He was an original member of the European Commission Working Group that drafted Directive 2001/45/EC which lead to the Work at Height Regulations 2005. As a member of the HSE Construction

Industry Advisory Committee (CONIAC) for 9 years, falls from a height was a regular topic in regulatory and advisory discussions.

Nigel is a Chartered Fellow of the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health; and in May 2000, was awarded the Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents' (RoSPA) Distinguished Service Award for his 'outstanding contribution to the cause of health and safety at work.' In June 2002, Nigel was awarded the OBE for 'services to occupational health and safety.'
